Dick worked as an electrical engineer and program manager on many aircraft and satellite earth station antennas and amplifiers as well as laser target designators. Dick retired from Hughes in February 1988 and was active in HARA until moving to Tucson in 1999. Dick and Joan thoroughly enjoyed being part of Hughes family and maintained friendships with their fellow Hughesites and their accounts at the Credit Union until they passed.

Hughes retiree Dr. Harold Rosen was added to the Air and Space Forces Association Chapter 147 General Bernard A. Schriever Wall of Honor in 2022.

The award was named after General Schriever because he was the chief architect of the U.S. Air Force's ballistic missile and space programs which he started at an Inglewood, California school house in July 1954.

To date, Dr. Rosen is the only Hughes employee named on the Wall of Honor.


Each year, Chapter 147 and the US Space Force Space Systems Command selects up to six names to be added to the Wall of Honor.
