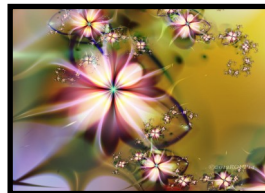

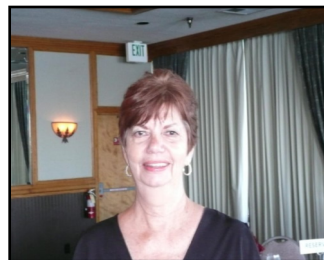

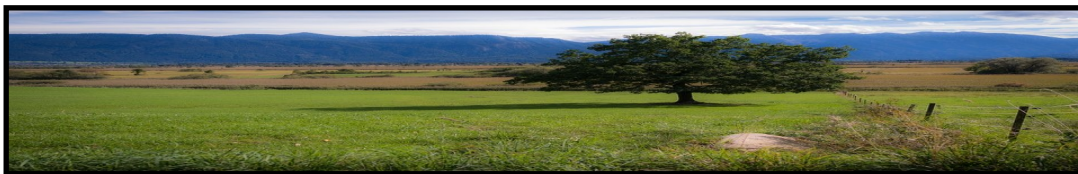


Richard (Dick) Reaser

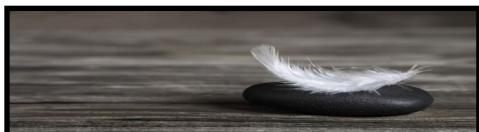

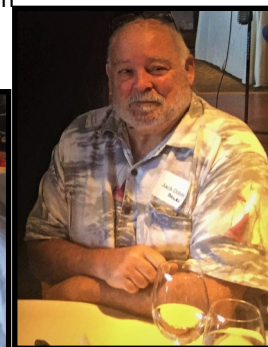

Dr. Harold Rosen honored by local Air and Space Forces Association

Hughes retiree Dr. Harold Rosen was added to the Air and Space Forces Association Chapter 147 General Bernard A. Schriever Wall of Honor in 2022.

The award was named after General Schriever because he was the chief architect of the U.S. Air Force’s ballistic missile and space programs which he started at an Inglewood, California school house in July 1954.

To date, Dr. Rosen is the only Hughes employee named on the Wall of Honor.

One of our HARA members, Rick Reaser, is very interested in receiving information about other Hughes employees who have made significant technical, operational, business, or management contributions to Department of Defense Space programs.

Each year, Chapter 147 and the US Space Force Space Systems Command selects up to six names to be added to the Wall of Honor.

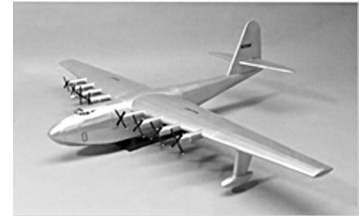
