He worked as a Project Manager, Program Manager and District Marketing Manager. Kay retired in 1992.

Kay loved playing golf, playing poker with his friends, and also playing bridge. He was an avid hunter and gun collector.

Richard Alan "Dick" Greenblatt


August 14, 1924 - March 27, 2023

Dick worked at Hughes Aircraft from 1955-1992 as an engineer and international marketing manager, which sent him to Tokyo, Japan (where he fatefully met his future wife, Shizuko) to represent the far-east region, and to Los Angeles where he lived until his passing. His hobbies included collecting Asian antiques and weightlifting. He won several world, Pan-American and U.S. Grand Master weightlifting championships, most recently winning the U.S. Men's Grand Master Champion overall title in November of 2020.
